

#### **Paul Kurtz**

Paul was born and raised in Whitestone, the youngest of John and Marion Kurtz' 5 children. He spent his summers at Beechhurst Beach while attending P.S 193, 194 and then St. Francis Prep.

After leaving SUNY Buffalo Paul worked as a bartender at the White House restaurant. He joined the Navy Reserves in 2004 and went back to school to become an EMT. Paul's Navy service helped pay for nursing school, and he's been an RN at LIJ Medical center for 3 years.

Paul has spent most of his 18 years in the Navy Reserve in the Coastal Riverine Squadron known as the "Riverines" (They've since changed the name to Mobile Security Squadron, or MESRON) he has been mobilized overseas twice. Most recently in 2016 when he spent a year in Djibouti, a small country on the Horn of Africa doing anti-terrorism gunboat patrols in protection of large Navy cargo ships. 




