Join the Whitestone Civic Association and help us make our community stronger and better. We can't wait to welcome you as a member!





Joe was born in Brownsville, Brooklyn to Italian immigrants in March 1941. He migrated to East New York, Canarsie and finally, in 1973, to Beechhurst. Married to Nicoletta since January 1965, they have four boys, born between December 1965 and February 1971, and nine grandchildren from toddlers to young adults.

Joe has always been an entrepreneur, owning various small businesses in New York since the early 1970s, including hair salons, supermarkets and Italian restaurants. His Manhattan hair salon was well known among celebrities and Joe was the personal stylist for Elizabeth Taylor in the mid-1970s. In the early 1990s Joe wanted to stay closer to home and opened Marraccino Hair Salon in the North Shore Farms (formerly Waldbaum's) shopping center.

Joe and his wife, Nickie, have been residents of Beechhurst for over 50 years. His memoirs include lively stories of family time at Beechhurst Beach and his years as a hair salon owner in the North Shore Farms (formerly Waldbaum's) shopping center.

Joe did his basic army training in Knoxville, Tennessee in 1963 and competed his service Colorado Springs, Colorado through to 1965.

Joe's family is so proud that he put pen to paper so others can read these surprising anecdotes. Written during the 2020 lockdown, Joe describes how always putting family first helped shape his journey from a Brooklyn trouble-maker to personal hairdresser for a classic cinema star (Elizabeth Taylor), from running a supermarket in Flushing, learning to make pizza in Rego Park and owning Marracino Hair Salon in Whitestone.


